DIRECTIONS

Juan Pelota Ranch is private property and open only during special events. Please be respectful that certain parts of the property will be closed/off limits during these events, especially the house & garage area so that we are all welcome back in the future to ride the trails again.

From the intersection of Hwy 290 McGregor Ln. in Dripping Springs, TX.
Head North on McGregor Ln.

At Mile 3.7, turn right on Fitzhugh Rd. then immediately left back onto McGregor Ln headed North.

At Mile 6.2, you will see a sign for McGregor Ln. to the left and several others (Raeford Crossing, Hillview Trail, Norwood Loop) straight ahead. Go straight following Raeford Crossing.

At Mile 7.5, Norwood Loop (Not Norwood Rd.) forks off to the left. Go left on Norwood Loop.

At 8.3 miles, you will see a Yellow Boulder and a road that goes to the left. That is Dead Mans Hole Rd so take a left there. The gate to the parking area will be at the top of the hill to the right.
